

Position Available for Research Associate (Data Manager/Analyst)

A position is available for a Research Associate (Data Manager/Analyst) at Brock University, in St. Catharines, Ontario, in the heart of the beautiful Niagara Region. This position entails data management, statistical analysis, writing of reports and manuscripts, and presentation of findings. The successful candidate will have contact with students and faculty in the Faculty of Graduate Studies, and Department of Community Health Sciences in the Faculty of Applied Health Sciences. This successful candidate will primarily be involved with activities leading to the successful completion of the *Pan-Canadian Early Detection of Lung Cancer Study*.

The position requires a background in epidemiology and biostatistics, and competency and skills in Stata statistical package (Stata Corp, College Station, Texas). Analysis will be carried out for the most part in Stata statistical package and to a lesser extent in R statistical package. Strong capabilities in statistical analyses are essential. Complete competency in verbal and written English is required.

The position will start as soon as can be comfortably arranged by the successful applicant. The position is funded until September 30, 2013. The annual salary depends on the experience and qualifications of the candidate, and is expected to be in the range of \$45,000 to \$60,000, plus extended health and dental benefits if eligible. It is anticipated that the successful candidate will have a Master of Science degree or higher. The position will remain open until a successful candidate is found.
